I am Father Matthias Lugendo, Catholic priest ordained on August 2, 2014 from the Diocese of Kiyinda Mityana Uganda East Africa. As a priest, I thank God for giving me a spirit that loves to serve the poor, the elderly, the needy and the marginalized. The service to the elderly started in my childhood before I entered the minor seminary because I took care of the elderly in our village where I lived; I collected water and firewood for them and helped them in various ways. In college I visited them when I was not busy in class. After ordination, I was appointed assistant pastor at the cathedral. My spirit towards the elderly, the needy and the poor grew especially as I had the opportunity to visit different sub-parishes where I routinely encountered them in great numbers. It made me cry when I saw some of them living in conditions beyond which animals cannot live. It is a demanding job because it requires going to different villages to bring food to our seniors, especially when you have no means of transport.



On August 3, we presented a gift to Joseph Frey from CCW. He left for a new life in the Seminary on August 4. Let's continue to pray for him and his family.

Dignity of Life




