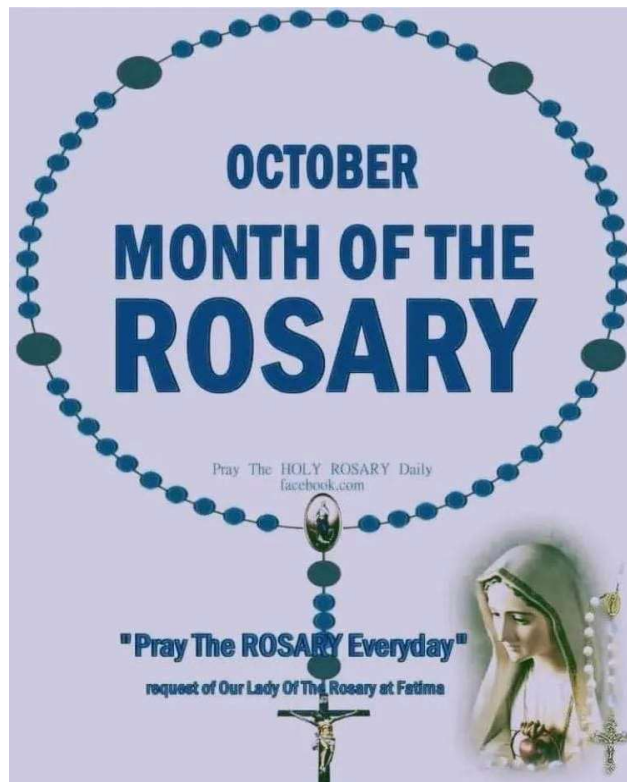

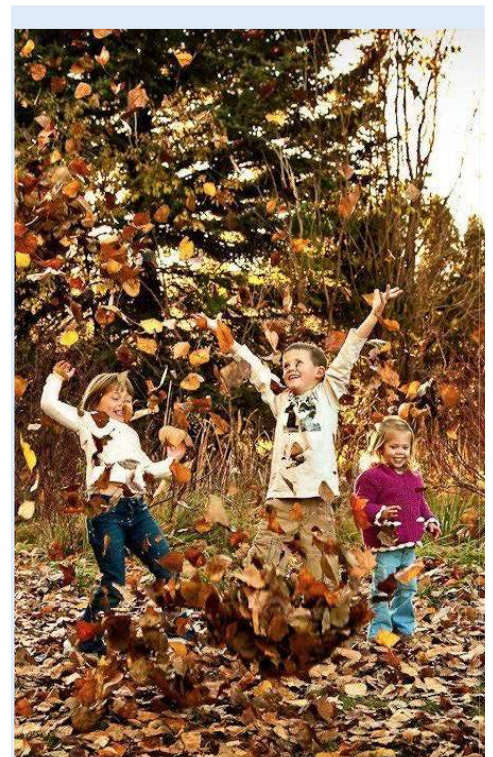
Dignity of Life
